[Execute late Check-ins and Traffic]

“Hearing no further check-ins or traffic, I will close this weeks’ net for the Lake County Illinois. . . Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service and Amateur Radio Emergency Service. This is **(YOUR CALL)** returning the repeater back to normal service.”
